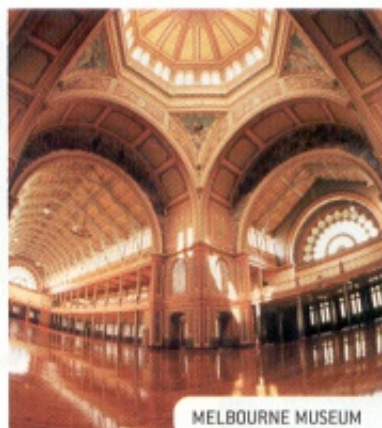
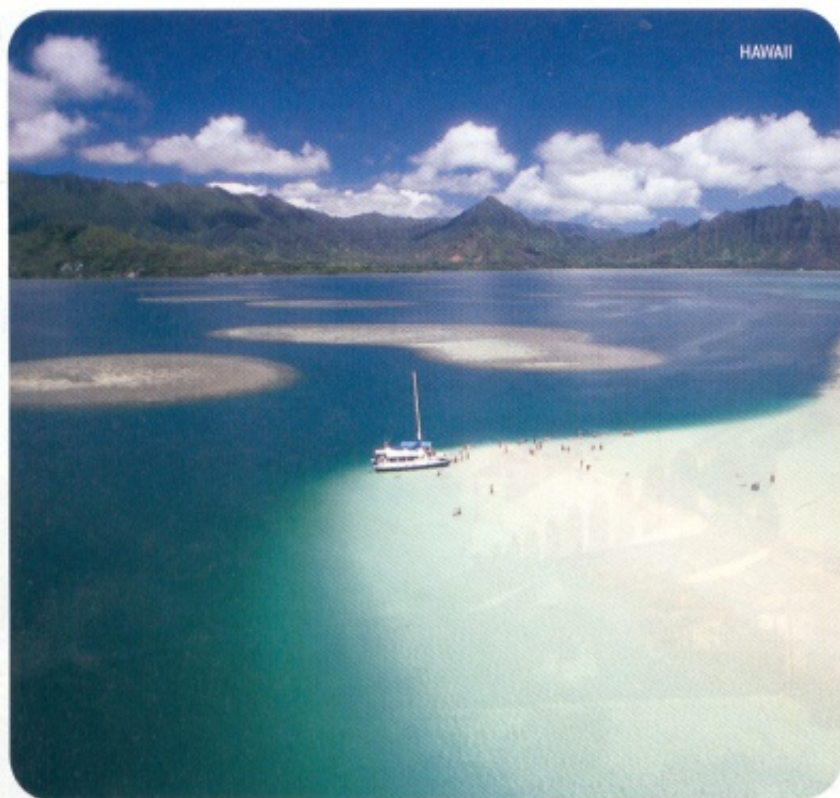

#### PACIFIC DESTINATION

Ever since Captain Cook dropped anchor Hawaii has been the destination stop for travelers worldwide. In fact, it was recently named in a gay marketing survey as the number one desired vacation spot.

The most famous gay bar in the Pacific is Hula's located at 134 Kapahulu Avenue, with large open windows, strip nights, a glassed-in dance floor and an amicable crowd. It sits above Kapiolani Park with distant views of Queen's Surf Beach at the eastern end of Waikiki. Here, the speedo crowd bakes under the brilliant Hawaiian sun.

A short walk from Hula's is the Cabana at Waikiki. The four-story property is bright and central, with a whirlpool, continental breakfast and friendly staff. If the Cabana is booked up, the owners recently opened up

another elegant property nearby called the Paradise View Hotel. If you want time off the beach then from May 30 to June 3 is a good time: The prestigious Honolulu Gay & Lesbian Film Festival showcases over 50 films at historic theaters.
